3.	0230		Bn S-2/Bde S-2: On 11 Jul 70, B Co, 1/8 Cav was preparing to backlog enemy ammo found in a cache on 10 Jul at YU 249439. Local patrols went out to maintain security while ammo was prepared for backlog. 3rd plt, B Co moved generally north from B Co which was working on a pad. They stopped short of an open field approximately 150 meters across and sent up a 5 man patrol to recon this field located at YU 248443. A MG was set up on the south side of the field while two men from the patrol walked up either side of the field staying near the woodline. They had walked about 75 meters when 2 skirmish lines of approximately 40 to 50 NVA came out of the woodline on the north side of the field walking south. They were wearing fresh green NVA fatigues with AK47 and had with helmet or boonie hats. The men from the 3rd plt realizing what was happening, immediately took the		

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3.	0230		Continuation from page 1: enemy under fire killing two outright by small arms. The patrols MG on the other side of the field opened fire. The NDA returned fire by small arms and automatic weapon but immediately broke retreating to the woodline north of the clearing. Based on what the patrol saw and the volume of enemy fire which included at least one IMG, they estimated they were up against an enemy company. The two individuals from the patrol crawled back to their MG while the rest of the 3rd pat moved up to support the patrol. Mortar fire, artillery fire, airstrikes and ARA expended on the north side of the clearing and a nearby gully running east west about 20 to 30 meters in the woodline north of the field. The enemy was disorganized to say the least. They would retreat into the gully only to be pounded by all the fire support. When the enemy went south towards the clearing, the 3rd plt would force them back with their organic firepower. The river between Vietnam and Cambodia cut off escape to the north. Mortar fire and artillery along with CS used to prevent any east or west

A pink team flying over the area detected movement in a gully running northeast from the eastern and east west gully north of the clearing. Napalm was immediately dropped along that whole area. B Co moved up the 3rd plt and contact was initiated when the enemy was again sighted at the north side of the clearing at 1610H. Contact remained sporadic until it broke at 1738H. A pink team working in the area reported killing 02 individuals and saw 02 KIA. Air strike, 01 KIA-ARA, 01 KIA. While cobra gunships were making runs, B Co reported seeing a smoke trail of what was believed to be a B40 rocket. The gunship was not hit. B Co swept the woodline and part of the gully on the north side of the field, and after a partial search pulled back to a night location beginning at 1810H. JS TB
